

### 4.3 Homework Tip

Dealing with data from other languages: When working a problem involving data from another language, some assumptions based on your knowledge of (our theory of the syntax of) English will be helpful, and indeed necessary to work the problem, and some will get in the way. It is therefore good idea to figure out what your assumptions are and consider each in turn to see if it seems to be helpful, or if, without it, the problem would be easier.
