

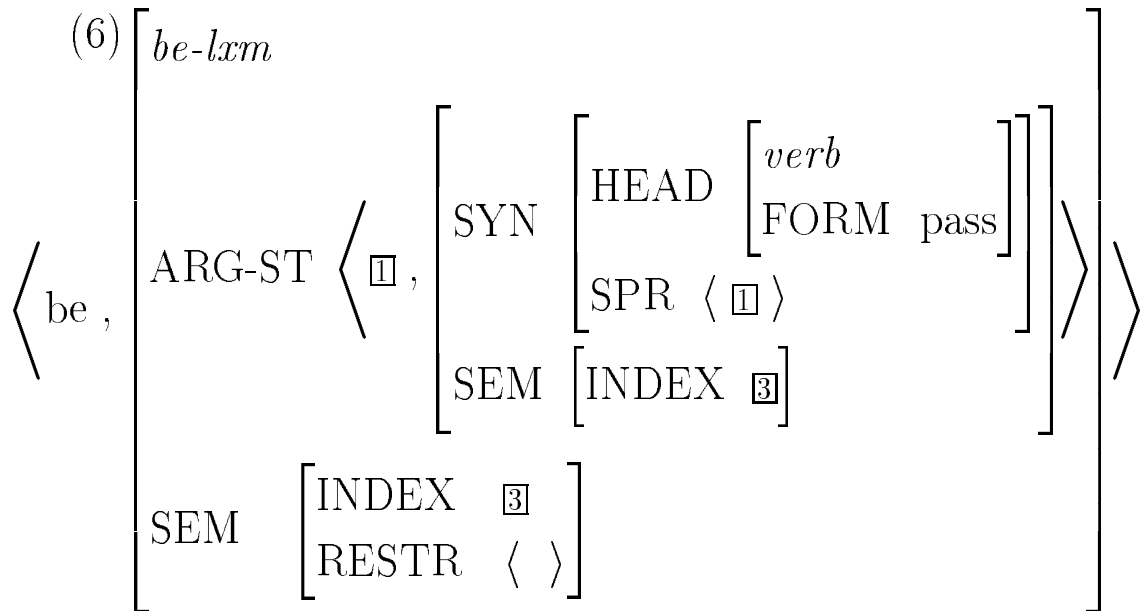
## 10.2 Slides

- (1) Uns ist kalt  
us[DAT] is cold  
'We are cold'
  
- (2) Hier wird nicht getanzt  
here is not danced  
'There is no dancing here'
  
- (3) Tvayā āsyatām  
you-inst sit-3rd-sing-imp  
'Let it be sat by you!'  
(‘Please have a seat!’)

## (4) Passive Lexical Rule

$$\left\langle \boxed{\mathbb{I}}, \left[ \begin{array}{l} tv-lxm \\ \text{ARG-ST} \quad \langle \text{NP}_i \rangle \oplus \boxed{\mathbb{a}} \end{array} \right] \right\rangle \Rightarrow \\
 \left\langle F_{PSP}(\boxed{\mathbb{I}}), \left[ \begin{array}{l} word \\ \text{SYN} \quad \left[ \text{HEAD} \quad \left[ \text{FORM} \quad \text{pass} \right] \right] \\ \text{ARG-ST} \quad \boxed{\mathbb{a}} \oplus \left\langle \left( \text{PP} \left[ \begin{array}{l} \text{FORM} \quad \text{by} \\ \text{P-OBJ} \quad \text{NP}_i \end{array} \right] \right) \right\rangle \end{array} \right] \right\rangle$$

- (5) a. The painting got **stolen** (by a thief).
- b. **Read** by almost every high school sophomore, *Hamlet* may be the most well-known of Shakespeare's plays.
- c. Anyone **liked** by that many people should surely run for office.
